buried;


He descended into hell; the third day He rose again from the dead;

 A Little About
Liberia

- Liberia is a country of just over 4.7 million people.
- There are over 100,000 orphans in Liberia.
- Many are orphaned due to disease. Over 11,000 people died from an Ebola outbreak in 2013-2014. More than 28,000 of Liberia's orphans have lost parents due to HIV/AIDS.
- Many more are orphaned from war. More than 250,000 people died in a civil war that lasted longer than a decade.
- Many children in Liberian orphanages have at least one parent who is still living. In Liberia, almost 90% of the population lives on less than \$3.00/day and many times, these parents simply can't afford to care for their children so they take them to institutions.



On the way out of our service today there will be an opportunity to give to a special fund as we're trying to raise enough money to fund scholarship students in Liberia to attend REAP camp this summer. We have reached our initial goal! But we would love to be able send another child to camp, so please feel free to keep giving!

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 5:11-15

¹¹ Therefore, knowing the fear of the Lord, we persuade others. But what we are is known to God, and I hope it is known also to your conscience. ¹² We are not commending ourselves to you again but giving you cause to boast about us, so that you may be able to answer those who boast about outward appearance and not about what is in the heart. ¹³ For if we are beside ourselves, it is for God; if we are in our right mind, it is for you. ¹⁴ For the love of Christ controls us, because we have concluded this: that one has died for all, therefore all have died; ¹⁵ and he died for all, that those who live might no longer live for themselves but for him who for their sake died and was raised.
